



GROOMING & UNIFORM POLICIES

BOYS HAIR:

- Hair must be clean, combed neatly and trimmed above the collar and above the ear at all times.
- Shaved heads, spikes, mo-hawk, pompadour, punk styles, dyed hair, faded haircuts and hair tails are prohibited.
- Haircut must be a classic taper. Fade cuts cannot be shaved with less than a #2 blade length all around.
- If hair is shaved also on the sides and back, then length of the hair on top cannot be longer than 1.5 inches or shaved with more than a #4 blade length.
- Students arriving to school with unacceptable hairstyles/haircuts will be sent home.

GIRLS HAIR:

- Hair must be kept clean, neat and well combed at all times.
- Hair cannot be dyed.
- Hair accessories for girls must be maroon, gold and/or white only.

JEWELRY:

- A maximum of one thin chain with one pendant allowed. These must not be visible and must be maintained inside the shirt.
- A maximum of one ring and one thin bracelet allowed.
- Only one small earring allowed in each ear.
- No hoop-style, long or colored earrings allowed.
- Jewelry must be kept to a minimum at all times.
- We discourage the use of jewelry and will not be held responsible for any lost items.

MAKE-UP/NAIL POLISH:

- Absolutely no make-up, nail polish or acrylic nails allowed; these will be removed. Nails must be clean and trimmed at all times.

UNIFORMS:

- All Highpoint students are required to wear complete school uniform, including shoes and uniform winter attire, at all times. Students not wearing complete uniform will not be allowed in class. Non-uniform attire will be removed.
- Winter attire: When temperature in the morning is 50 degrees or less, girls may wear khaki pants under their uniform tops. Boys and girls may wear layers of white or cream colored turtleneck, undershirt and/or tights UNDERNEATH their uniform during cold days. ONLY maroon Highpoint Jackets, Sweatshirts, Sweaters may be worn on top. All other jackets will be removed. *Note: If temperature is below 60 degrees during lunchtime, lunch may be served inside and/or students may remain inside throughout the day.*
