Duty Times: Mornings from 7:30-8:15 a.m. Afternoons from 2:55 - 3:30 p.m.

Program Objectives: Highpoint's Safety Patrol Program allows 5th-8th Grade students who maintain a 2.5 GPA (C average) as well as good conduct (B average or better) the opportunity to assist in enforcing our School's safety rules throughout the school day.

Safety Patrol's Mission: A Safety Patrol's job is to remind students of the school safety rules and to guide them upon arrival, dismissal, and movement throughout the building in the safest manner possible.

Trainings: School Safety Patrols receive training instructions and guideline procedures during their training session and/or regular patrol meetings.

School Safety Patrol DUTIES:

- Attend and participate in all patrol meetings and training sessions.
- Assist students upon arrival and watching for traffic safety violations at their assigned posts.
- Assist with morning Arrival Scans as well as afternoon Dismissal Scans as needed.
- Obey all school rules and set a good example for other children, displaying fairness and good sportsmanship at all times.
- Report for duty on time with his/her safety patrol vest.
- Remind students to walk in the hallways during arrival and dismissal times.
- Assist in maintaining the safety of all students during school events.
- Report to the faculty advisor, administrators, and/or staff members as needed.
