## GRADING, TESTING \& HOMEWORK POLICIES

GRADING and WEIGHT SCALE:

- A MINIMUM of ten (10) grades is required for each core subject prior to the end of each Quarter. At least one (1) grade per week must be posted on KoolGround for all classes. A MINIMUM of (2) tests, (4) quizzes, (1) project, and (3) homework/classwork grades per Quarter. No "pop" quizzes allowed.
Grades will be closed the week prior to Report Cards.
Grade weight scale: Tests (35\%), quizzes (30\%), projects (20\%), and homework/classwork/participation (15\%) $=100 \%$
Grade Scale: A: 100-90
B: 89-80
C: 79-70
D: 69-60
F: 59 or below (Failure)


## POLICIES ON QUIZZES and TESTS

- Publisher-created tests and quizzes with 10 questions or less must ALWAYS include a Teacher prepared EXTRA-CREDIT question.
- Tests should be varied in format, ie: multiple choice, fill in the blanks, true/false, short answers, essay, etc.
- If at least fifty ( $50 \%$ ) percent of the students earned a $65 \%$ or below on any test or quiz, the test or quiz must be tossed and those students must re-take the same test with a ten (10) point deduction.
All information included in a test or quiz must have previously been taught and reviewed in class using different teaching strategies; (auditory/visual/kinesthetic).
A MAXIMUM of THREE Tests or Quizzes may be administered in one day.
- "Study Guides" must be created by the students and cannot have the exact questions as those on a test or quiz.
- Outlines of notes are encouraged for all grade levels to teach Study Skills; (3rd thru 8th Grades).
- Think and analyze on the capacity of each child, their personal situation, background and academic abilities PRIOR to posting a " 0 ". Encourage students to take their time and proofread before handing in a test or quiz.
- Students may only use pencils up to $4^{\text {th }}$ Grade. Blue or Black pens ONLY and white-out required (Grades $5^{\text {th }}$ thru $^{\text {th }}$ ).
- Cursive handwriting is REQUIRED in all subjects from Grades 3rd thru 8th; (cursive in $1^{\text {st }}$ Grade starts in January and continues in $2^{\text {nd }}$ Grade.)
Return the work to Students that turn in a test or quiz with scratch-offs, doodling, no name or no date. They must either add the information or white-out the scratch-offs until it's presentable.
