



SUMMER 2023 READING & MATH REVIEW

We believe it is very important to encourage our students to read and reinforce their academic skills over the summer break. In order to ensure that happens, all students entering 1st thru 8th Grade in 2023-2024 will be required to read a novel over the summer break AND complete an IXL Assignment (*includes practice for both MATH & LANGUAGE ARTS*).

Summer Reading:

All summer reading book selections were made available for purchase through Scholastic Books during our school's Book Fair that took place in April. If you were unable to purchase your book at that time, you may order them online through BarnesandNoble.com or Amazon.com.

Guided Reading Questions have been provided by each teacher to help students measure comprehension as they read along. These questions do NOT have to be answered on paper! They are to be used as reflection to monitor understanding only. Teachers will be reviewing both the novel and the questions with students when classes resume. Students in 2nd Grade thru 8th Grade will be tested on their summer reading at the end of their first full week of school.

IXL Math and Language Arts Assignments:

Students will be assigned IXL Practice Skills to work on over the summer break of which they will have to complete 20 Skills by the first day of school. Completion of a minimum of 10 Math skills and 10 Language Arts Skills is required for students to begin the school year. Students will receive a grade for completing their IXL by the first day of school with a proficiency grade of 80% or above.

Access to IXL:

All CURRENT Highpoint Students have access to IXL using the same log in credentials they used during the school year.

All NEWLY ENROLLED Highpoint Students must contact the Main Office to request their log-in credentials.
